**GRANT COUNTY FAIR AND RODEO COURT POLICIES  
AND RULES OF CONDUCT  
COURT REIGN OCTOBER 1<sup>ST</sup>- SEPT 30<sup>TH</sup>**

**COURT RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. Each court member must either have their own horse or have a signed, long term lease on a horse
2. Horses must be healthy, with current vaccination and worming.
3. The horse must be kept clean, trimmed, and shod.
4. No stallions, late term pregnant mares, or mares with foals allowed.
5. Each court member is responsible for her own horse and her horse's transportation.
6. It is required that a parent or the Fair Court Advisor accompany the Fair Court to all appearances.
7. The Fair board highly recommends the court be involved in 4H and Cinnabar Mountain Playdays Grand Entry. Applications are attached. Any fees will be paid out of the court budget.

**REQUIRED APPEARANCES**

1. The Fair and Rodeo Court are expected to wear their hats, crowns, and sashes, depending on event and/or approval of advisor, manager or chaperone at any public event when they are representing the Grant County Fair.
2. Hair must be of natural color, all piercings must be in ears only, no visible tattoos while representing the Grant County Fair Grounds
3. Required Attendance: This will be updated yearly with court advisor, fair manager and the fair board
  - Coronation for future court November 19, 2019
  - Spray Rodeo ~ parade and grand entry
  - 62 Days parade
  - 4<sup>th</sup> of July parades (court will represent at the community the advisor & court agrees to)
  - Grant County Fair Parade August
  - Grant County Fair and Rodeo and Jr. Rodeo ~ grand entries and any appearance as time permits
    - Wednesday Team Branding, Dog Trials
    - Friday Appearance at the concert (possibly help at the gate or showing people where to sit)
    - Saturday Bullfighting. Court will work with Rodeo committee for grand entry
  - Harney County Fair and Rodeo ~ parade
  - NPRA Rodeo Grant County Fairgrounds(TBA)
  - As many surrounding county Fair and Rodeos as possible.

4. All appearances, whether fair sponsored, local or out of county, must have the Fair Court Advisors' approval first.
5. All traveling and meals for appearances must be budgeted.
6. Participation in Fair sponsored activities throughout the year is strongly encouraged as time permits.
7. If an out of county event conflicts with a local event, the local event takes precedence.

### **RULES OF CONDUCT**

1. It is the duty and obligation of all court members to portray the highest moral standards. The court must portray good sportsmanship to other court members, Fair Board, Court Advisors and all people they may encounter.
2. The court needs to stay in contact with the Court Advisor, manager or chaperone(s).
3. Contestants are not permitted to drink alcoholic beverages, smoke, or use foul language at any time during the contest or during their reign.
4. No public display of affection, misconduct, illegal and/or illicit behavior, will not be tolerated and may be cause for immediate dismissal.
5. If a court member is dismissed or is unable to fulfill their contract they are not eligible to compete in the future. Any items purchased, given or donated to the dismissed member must be returned to the Fair Board along with all revolving items. The dismissed court member will be held responsible and billed for any items not returned.
